JUNETEENTH WALK FOR RACIAL JUSTICE



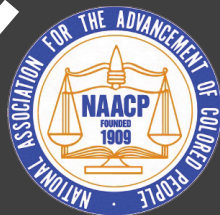
You're invited to celebrate **Juneteenth**, a day that commemorates the ending of slavery in the United States. This event is open to the community and is

hosted by the Ann Arbor branch of the NAACP and the Protectors of Equality in Government in partnership with the City of Ann Arbor.

9 a.m.-noon. Join us anytime in a one-mile walk for racial justice beginning at Fuller Park (1519 Fuller Road) as we travel along the Border-to-Border trail to Wheeler Park (200 Depot Street).

Noon-2 p.m. Wheeler Park will be the host site of featuring speakers, videos and a time for reflection. We can gather with up to 100 people or join us online as a virtual participant. We encourage participants to wear masks and remain six feet apart from others at all times.

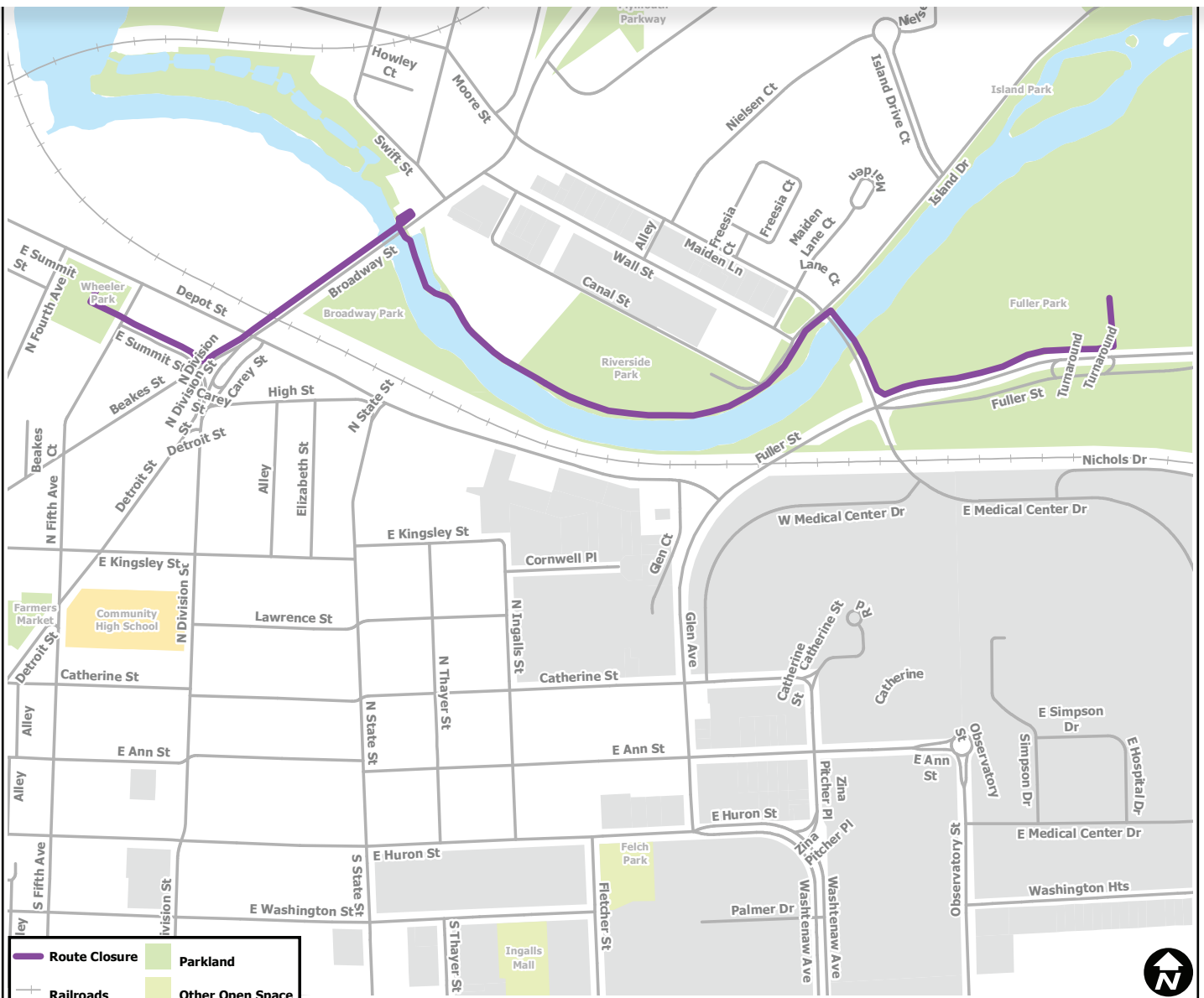
